**Community Development Block Grant Program Year 2016**

Pursuant to Federal guidelines, Grosse Ile Township is announcing its objectives and possible uses for projects using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

Total funds anticipated to be allocated for Grosse Ile Township for 2016-2017 Community Development Block Grant Program Year is \$48,547.09

**OBJECTIVES**

Activities funded by CDBG must meet at least one of the following four criteria:

- A. Benefit low and moderate income (LMI) person(s)
- B. Benefit low and moderate income limited clientele (LMC) persons
- C. Address slum and blight or low to moderate income housing benefit
- D. Meet a particularly urgent community development need
