

YARD WASTE GUIDELINES

Yard Waste: The miscellaneous waste material resulting from landscaping a home will include, but not be limited to grass, weeds, leaves, shrub clippings, twigs, tree trimmings (if not over two inches in diameter, four feet in length and tied in bundles and not to exceed sixty pounds). Also included shall be Christmas trees (whole), garden waste material, dirt incidental to minor plantings, etc.

Yard Waste Collection and Processing: The Contractor will collect yard waste on a weekly basis. The Contractor shall provide separate yard waste collection from the first full week of April through the second week of December of each contract year, with the exception that Christmas trees and Christmas garland may be collected separate from Household solid waste and processed as compost/yard waste in accordance with the specifications below.

Residents will be required to place grass and leaves in “Kraft” paper bags or properly marked 32-35 gallon containers with formed handles that are placed at the curbside. Containers shall be marked with a “Yard Waste Only” or “Compost” sticker. Other yard waste, such as tree limbs and brush, shall be tied in bundles, not to exceed four feet in length, two inches in diameter, 18 inches around and sixty pounds per bundle.

The Contractor shall, once each year, collect from each residence a discarded Christmas tree of any size (trees over 6 foot cut in ½ by the resident) along with miscellaneous Christmas garland, if placed at the curbside.
